

Directions

Livingston Student Center, 84 Joyce Kilmer Ave, Piscataway, NJ 08854 848-445-0405

Note – please be advised that 84 Joyce Kilmer Ave in *New Brunswick* is **NOT** the same location. Piscataway is correct.

From New Jersey Turnpike (North or South)

1. Take Turnpike N/S – turn off at exit 9.
2. After toll, bear right, follow sign to Rt. 18 North
3. Proceed along **Route 18 North**, crossing the Raritan River (approximately 3.7 miles). Continue on Route 18 North.
4. Take exit for **Livingston Campus** (this comes up right after the exit for Busch Campus) and turn off to the right onto **Avenue E**.
5. Continue on **Avenue E** and make a left turn at the second street onto **Rockefeller Road**.
6. Once on **Rockefeller Road**, make the first right (at the stop sign) onto **Joyce Kilmer Avenue**.
7. You may park in Lot 105 (Across from Student Ctr).

From Garden State Parkway (North or South)

1. Take Parkway exit #129.
2. Follow signs to NJ Turnpike South.
3. Take Turnpike South and follow directions from the Turnpike # 1-7.

From Route 1

1. Take exit for Rt. 18 North and follow directions from the Turnpike # 3-7.

From Route 287 North or South

1. Exit 9 (Bound Brook/Highland Park).
2. Proceed East on River Road toward Highland Park.
3. Continue on River Road and you will pass under the overpass for Route 18. Make the next left onto Route 18 North.
4. Follow directions from Turnpike # 4-7



Public Transportation Information

Trains

- [New Jersey Transit's](#) Northeast Corridor Line provides New Brunswick with both local and express service between Penn Station in New York and Newark and Trenton, New Jersey. (For Information 1-800-772-2222).
- [SEPTA](#) (Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority) provides service at Trenton to and from Philadelphia. (For Information 215/580-7800).
- [Amtrak](#) provides limited direct service to New Brunswick, however connections can easily be made via New Jersey Transit trains to principal Amtrak stations at MetroPark, New York and Trenton. (For Information 1-800/USA-RAIL).

From New Brunswick Train Station to Livingston Campus

- The New Brunswick Train Station is located at the corner of Albany Street and Easton Avenue across from the Rutgers Bookstore.
- Proceed up Easton Avenue (short hill) and turn right on Somerset Street.
- Proceed on Somerset Street for half a block and turn left onto College Avenue. You will see a bus stop where you can catch the "L" or "LX" campus bus to the Livingston Campus Student Center. There is no cost for utilizing the campus bus system.
